GLASSTAR GLASS FACTORY + KARLŠTEJN

• Are you fascinated by the beauty of Czech crystal?

Would you like to learn more about how it is made?

Part of this tour will be an excursion to a small family glass factory, concentrating on small-scale production. You will visit the production area where you can admire the craftsmanship of the local blowers and cutters. Each person can try it themselves and as a present everybody also gets a glass bonbon. After this excursion our bus will transfer you to Karltejn where you will enjoy tasty lunch, followed by excursion of Karltejn Castle.

Karlštejn Castle is one of the most visited castles in the Czech Republic. Built by Charles IV between 1348 and 1355, it originally served to safeguard the imperial and royal treasure and the Crown jewels and served also as the archive of state documents.

This gothic castle, enchanting you with its monumental architecture is situated about 38 km southwest of Prague. After climbing the hill, an hour lasting tour of the interiors awaits you. Your guide will acquaint you with not only the history of the castle, but also with the life of Charles IV and fine arts during his reign.

### MONDAY, JUNE 26<sup>TH</sup> KUTNÁ HORA

Kutná Hora a medieval centre of silver-mining, was the second richest town of Bohemian Kingdom. The variety of Kutná Hora architectural monuments and its well preserved structure of town centre reflects its ancient fame and wealth until present. Kutná Hora town has been registered at UNESCO heritage list since 1995.

There is one of the most interesting burial places in the world called Kostnice (Ossuary) in a small nearby village Sedlec. This chapel is decorated by more than 40.000 human bones, including e.g. a chandelier or the coat-of-arms of the noble family Schwarzenberg.

During your walk in Kutná Hora you will visit the gothic St. Barbara's Church and Italian Court-originally a Royal Mint. You will no less admire the other beautiful gothic, renaissance and baroque burgher houses or the unique stone well from 15<sup>th</sup> century.

In 1985 I was working with TNT on their express parcels side in Llantrisant, South Wales when I saw an advert showing an internal vacancy for a new division called TNT Exposervice based in Birmingham, I thought that sounds interesting and decided to apply. In November of that year I was interviewed for the position of Expo Co-Ordinator and I always remembered what my future boss said to me at the time, his words were "The exhibition industry is

something you'll either love or hate and you'll know very quickly, it's a beast of a game if the beast gets in you, it never leaves" how true those words were.

After a few years I moved on to join a company called Scott Hammond Limited but unfortunately after a few years due to a recession I was made redundant but the beast was in me. In 1998 I went for an interview with Europa European Express within their European Road Network but the job did nt inspire me and at the end of the interview the General Manager of the depot said "So then Jeff where's your heart" to which my reply was simple "It's in Exhibitions and not in your European Road Department. To my surprise he said to me "We might just have the job for you, as we are looking for someone to run our exhibitions department.

When I took over the exhibitions department I felt at home from day one. I was back where I wanted to be. My old boss was right if you love exhibitions that's it you'll never want to do anything else.

So what are my reasons for wanting to join the Board of Management, well I always believe that when you join any Trade Association/Body or Club you should always contribute something extra, not just sit back and watch others do the work. You get out of life what you put in and IELA is no different. I see IELA as something that needs to evolve rather than change, this can be a natural process and not something you have to force or push.

#### Rene Carvajal New Age of Internationa

Business Administrator, **Rene** started in the Industry in 1998 at AESI (first logistic exhibition company in Mexico) from the bottom of the organisation up to become Operation Manager and in 2002 started his own company with Edgar Gonzalez - NAIB Group.

At the beginning some people did not believed the company would live more than 3 months but thanks to

the hard work, the professionalism and moving their cards properly little by little they started to become the favorite company of organisers, government and foreign companies.

He held legal judgments against the Mexican government to avoid the VAT for foreign agents and gave a legal solution for the change of import status on exhibitions, he worked together with them for performing the first ATA operation in the country. Now days NAIB handle more than 120 exhibitions per year and it has diversified to concerts, broadcasting, museums, sports and events. Recently he opened a third company specialized on creating software focus on improving the international logistic operations.

At the beginning our goal was just to get the company to survive, however we got used to improve ourselves and becoming real competitive. As a result, we now understand that we had never forget who we are: "We are simple people giving the best of us to the industry for getting back - not just the economic or professional satisfaction- but creating strong friendship ties that generate wealth for everyone, this is also the IELA heart".

Jim Kelty started his exhibition industry career in 1976 in Indiana as the manager for Hardware Wholesaler's semiannual trade shows. After HWI, Jim moved to Chicago, Illinois to manage the Mid-American Horticultural Trade Show. He also served as managing director of the National Trade Show Exhibitors Association and managed its TS-2 exhibition.

After moving to California In 1981, Jim has worked

exclusively in the international transportation and logistics segment of the exhibition industry. He joined the Airways Freight team in 2002. Throughout his career, Jim has been involved in all aspects of the exhibition logistics business - from operations and customer service to business development and executive management.

Jim has been a member of several exhibition industry trade associations including: IAEM/IAEE (international committee chairman, external education committee member, and IAEM foundation trustee); EDPA; EACA (on the board of directors) NTSEA/TSEA (northern California chapter chairman); and the EXHIBITOR SHOW (exhibitor advisory committee member).

Jim attended IELA's first General Assembly and Congress, was IELA's first PR committee chairman and assisted in the development of the organisation's first publication, now known as IELA World. An External Auditor is typically used to **avoid conflicts of interest** and to **ensure the integrity of the auditing process**. When an audit is performed, it is the financial auditor's responsibility to make sure that records are examinated in an honest, professional and forthright manner.


